

ORDER No. **15-24**
SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
HUME LAKE RANGER DISTRICT
ROUGH FIRE CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Hume Lake Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from 12:00 p.m. on September 18, 2015, until the Rough Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon the Hume Lake Ranger District Rough Fire Closure Area. The Hume Lake Ranger District Rough Fire Closure Area begins at the intersection of the Sequoia National Forest and Highway 198 (Generals Highway) in Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, and then continues northwest approximately 7 miles along Highway 198 to its intersection with the Kings Canyon National Park Boundary in Section 18, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues northwest approximately 13 miles along the Sequoia National Forest boundary to its intersection with Highway 180 in Section 7, Township 14 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues northwest approximately 7.5 miles along Highway 180 to its intersection with the Sequoia National Forest boundary in Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 27 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues along the Sequoia National Forest boundary back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Hume Lake Ranger District, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Hume Lake Ranger District, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of any official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



