Recreational Opportunities Limited near Hume Lake

DUNLAP, California, August 28, 2015 – The Rough Fire, currently burning on the Sierra and Sequoia National Forests and Kings Canyon National Park has been impacting the recreation opportunities on the Hume Lake Ranger District. Developed campgrounds that are open include Stony Creek, Upper Stony Creek and Fir and Cove Group Campgrounds. Also open are Stony Creek Village Resort and Montecito Lake Resort.

These recreation sites may be closed for the upcoming Labor Day Holiday, depending on the conditions or if the smoke becomes hazardous, and poses a risk to the public. Safety issues to be aware of if you travel in the area are increased fire equipment on the road and poor visibility due to smoke.
