I am implementing a Forest Order to close the Corral Complex Area and all trails and roads within the Area, on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b). This Order is effective on September 5, 2013.

The purpose of this closure is to reduce the risk to the public and firefighting personnel on National Forest land within the Corral Complex Closure Area. The area is unsafe for public entry due to the Corral Complex wildfire, which is active within this area. Fire Management on the Shasta-Trinity has coordinated with the Six Rivers National Forest and the National Type 1 management team for the Corral Complex in recommending this area closures. Assessment factors include review of weather, fuel conditions, large fire behavior potential as well as fire suppression strategy and tactics.

I have concluded that this decision may be categorically excluded from documentation in an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) or Environmental Assessment (EA) under the National Environmental Policy Act. This action falls within the category identified in 36 CFR 220.6(d)(1) – prohibitions to provide short-term resource protection or to protect public health and safety – and does not require documentation in a decision memo, decision notice, or record of decision. Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 215.12(f), this decision is not subject to administrative appeal. I have determined that there are no extraordinary circumstances associated with this temporary closure and the procedures for legal notice and opportunity to comment (36 CFR 215.4) do not apply to this project. Implementation of the decision may begin immediately.



**Order No. 14-13-03**  
**SHASTA-TRINITY NATIONAL FOREST**  
**Temporary Closure Order**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Trinity River Management District of the Shasta-Trinity National Forest. This Order is effective from September 5, 2013, until the Corral Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within Corral Fire Closure Area. The Corral Fire Closure Area boundary begins at the junction of County Road No. 402 and Forest Road No. 7N26, then continues northeast along County Road No. 402 to its intersection with Forest Road No. 7N15, then continues north along Forest Road No. 7N15 to its intersection with the New River Trail Head, then continues north along Forest Trail No. 7E05 (New River Trail) to its intersection with Forest Trail No. 7E03 (Virgin Creek Trail), then continues north along Forest Trail No. 7E03 (Virgin Creek Trail) to its intersection with the Forest Boundary, then continues east along the Forest Boundary to its intersection with Salmon Summit, then continues south along the Forest Boundary to its intersection with Forest Road No. 7N26, then continues south along Forest Road No. 7N26 back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.53(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road within the Corral Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.54(e).
3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Corral Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine or not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.
