Air Quality Advisory

Unhealthy Conditions



For the following areas:

Trinity County: Weaverville, Hayfork, Trinity Pines, Wildwood, Big Bar, Junction City, Hyampom, Mad River, Burnt Ranch and Denny



Smoke levels in these areas have been classified as *Unhealthy* and are creating a health hazard. Depending upon your proximity to the fires, smoke concentrations are expected to be *Unhealthy*. These conditions are problematic for those with health conditions. Smoke Levels continue to be monitored. Please watch for updates.



People are recommended to restrict outdoor activity.

Symptoms that may be related to excess smoke exposure include:

- Repeated coughing
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Wheezing
- Chest tightness or pain
- Palpitations
- Nausea or unusual fatigue
- Lightheadedness
