## CURRENT FIRE SITUATION

The Northern Rockies Type 1 Incident Management Team will be assuming command of the Route Complex on Saturday August 15<sup>th</sup> at 6AM. The new fire management team will begin the transition process today in coordination with the Southern California Incident Management Team 1. They will continue to evaluate opportunities to conduct burnout operations and increase containment. The Incident Command Post will remain at the Southern Trinity School.

Total acreage of the Route Complex is 26,910. The Johnson Fire is at 25,102 acres, the Buck Fire is at 1,647 acres and the Chance Fire is at 161 acres. Containment is at 27%.

On the Johnson Fire, crews continued some burnout operations overnight along the southern edge. Last night's burnout operation on the east side of the fire near Hyampom successfully secured additional line. Crews will continue to conduct mop-up operations and patrol to hold the line. Crews also made progress improving dozer line along the western perimeter.

The Buck and Chance Fires have complete containment line and are in patrol status where crews will monitor any remaining fire activity.

## WEATHER

Temperatures forecasted for the mid-70's today and 30% humidity. A warming and drying trend is expected through the weekend.

## THE FOLLOWING ARE ALL CURRENT ROAD CLOSURES NEAR THE MAD RIVER AREA:

The following roads are closed to non-residents: Highway 36 from the junction of Van Duzen Road to Lower Mad River and the Van Duzen Road from the junction with Highway 36 to Ruth-Zenia Road.

The following roads are closed to all traffic: Highway 36 from the junction with Lower Mad River Road to Rattlesnake Road (29N58). Forest Route 1 five miles north of Highway 36 at Forest Service Road 2N12. Forest Service Road 4N18.
