The Burned Area Emergency Response (BAER) implementation team received funding to begin emergency stabilization.


Projects Underway: Hazard tree mitigation; improve and stormproof roads for drainages; stabilize and repair trails; detect, treat and monitor invasive weeds; install public warning signs, gates, and barricades for public safety; and to protect cultural and natural resources. Accomplishments are listed below.

Road Treatments:

- Reestablishing route markers (96% complete) on roads.
- Installing public warning signs, gates, and barricades.

Protection/Safety:

- Hazard tree mitigation on 240 miles (72% complete) along priority roads and recreation sites.
- Hazard tree mitigation (76% completed) and erosion control measures (23% complete) are put in place for 29 archeological sites to prevent post-fire damage.
