Bullards Fire Update

Camptonville, CA... Yesterday's cooler, moister weather assisted firefighters as they made good progress building line around the fire. Based on the progress of line construction, the Incident Commanders and Yuba County Sheriff's Office lifted the evacuation for fire area residents. The Bullards Bar Reservoir is still closed to recreation.

Weather – Highs in the 60's and humidity levels at 38%.

Size – 900 acres

Containment – 20%

Evacuations – None for residents. Bullards Bar Reservoir closed to recreationists

Road Closures Still in Effect –

- Oregon Hill Road from Moran to Marysville Road
- Marysville Road from Merriam to Moonshine Road
- Moran Road is closed to the general public but open to area residents

Agencies Responding - Forest Service, CAL FIRE, Yuba County Sheriff's Department, CHP, PG&E, CA Department of Corrections, private contractors, and local fire agencies including North San Juan, Dobbins-Oregon House, Camptonville, Linda, and others.

The fire began Friday afternoon, August 27, and is burning in Yuba County south of Bullards Bar Reservoir on both sides of the North Yuba River on the Tahoe and Plumas National Forests. The cause is under investigation.
