### **BULLARDS FIRE UPDATE**

**Camptonville, CA...** Firefighters continue to mop-up all hot spots 300 feet in from the fire perimeter. Management objectives include identifying fire suppression repair work and initiating the fire suppression repair plan. Significant demobilization of excess firefighting resources continues.

Crews working throughout the night discovered a spot fire outside of the fire's perimeter. The spot fire only grew to 20 feet by 75 feet in size and fire line was constructed immediately to stop its spread.

All evacuations and road closures have been lifted; however, Oregon Hill Road is open with controlled access. The public is encouraged to use caution when traveling through the fire area, as firefighters, utility crews, and large equipment operators may be working on or near the highway and side roads. Bullards Bar recreation areas and campgrounds are also open.

#### **Weather Outlook:**

Sunny – High temperatures will be 81-86° and humidity levels will be 18-24%.

**Size** – 1,307 acres

**Injuries** – 1 (broken foot)

**Containment** – 90%

**Full Containment is Expected** – Tuesday, August 31, 2010

36 Hand Crews

48 Engines

11 Dozers

4 Helicopters (for day shift)

Air Tankers are available if needed (for day shift)

**Total Personnel** – 1,077

**Agencies Responding** - Forest Service, CAL FIRE, Yuba County Sheriff's Department, CHP, PG&E, CA Department of Corrections, private contractors, and local fire agencies including North San Juan, Dobbins-Oregon House, Camptonville, Nevada County Consolidated, Grass Valley, Penn Valley, and Linda Fire.

The fire began Friday afternoon, August 27, and is burning in Yuba County south of Bullards Bar Reservoir on both sides of the North Yuba River on the Tahoe and Plumas National Forests. The cause remains under investigation.

**FIRE STATUS BRIEFING NOTICE TO AREA RESIDENTS:** Due to the slowing of fire suppression activity, updates will now be posted once daily in the morning.
