Summary:

The Rocky Mountain Type 2 Blue Team (IMT) transferred command of the Hayden Pass Fire from the Type 3 organization at 8:00 PM. last night. Incident Commander Jay Esperance, "We will be building on the successes of the local firefighters who have done an outstanding job with the limited resources they have."

Firefighters engaged in point protection on the structures through the night. As expected, fire behavior was less active last night.

Today, firefighters will continue structure protection on all sections of the fire. Helicopters, engines and handcrews will continue to mitigate hazards around homes. Additional resources are arriving today to supplement current fire staffing. Resources are actively monitoring fire progression as it moves into the Sangre de Cristo Wilderness and away from private land.

Fire behavior will be active again today, creating a column of smoke similar to yesterday. The inversion this morning has pushed smoke into Salida, but that should clear by noon.
