HAYDEN PASS BAER PUBLIC MEETING MONDAY NIGHT

The Hayden Pass Interagency BAER Assessment Team is hosting a public meeting on Monday, August 1 evening at 4:30pm at the Cotopaxi High School Gym.

At this meeting, the BAER team will present their burned area assessment report findings including burned area conditions, values-at-risk, and treatment options.

Doors open at 4:00pm for an open house opportunity to meet and speak individually with BAER assessment team specialists. There will another opportunity after the formal public meeting is over at 5:30pm for the public to meet and speak with the BAER team specialists.

SPECIAL NOTE: *Everyone near and downstream from the **Hayden Pass Fire** burned area should remain alert and stay updated on weather conditions that may result in heavy rains over the fire area. Flash flooding may occur quickly during heavy rain events.
