**Road Closure ~ Little Queens Fire
*For Public Safety***

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all roads as described in this order, within the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Using any type of motorized vehicle on the road (as described below). **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS DESCRIPTION:

National Forest System (NFS) Road #205 (China Basin Road) is described as beginning at the intersection with NFS Road 205K, located in Township 6 North, Range 11 East, Section 34 and continuing Northwesterly to the road's intersection with NFS Road 206 (Queens River Road) located in Township 6 North, Range 11 East, Section 20.

NFS Road #206 (Queens River Road) is described as beginning at the junction with NFS Road 268 (Middle Fork Boise River Road) located in Township 6 North, Range 11 East, Section 30 and continuing Northeasterly to the Queens River Trailhead, located in Township 6 North, Range 11 East, Section 20.

The above described Roads are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Elmore County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.


PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Little Queens Fire). These roads are closed to motorized vehicles for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closed roads is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
