AREA CLOSURE
Mack Fire – Version #1
For Public Safety

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all lands as described in this order, within the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This order will go into effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area (as described in this order). **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Mack Fire Area is described as all National Forest System (NFS) lands (including all National Forest System Roads and Trails within the area) beginning at the confluence of Macks Creek and Grimes Creek, located at Township 5 North, Range 4 East, Section 16; continuing Northwesterly along Macks Creek to the creek's intersection with the boundary line between Range 3 East and Range 4 East; continuing North along the Range 3 East and Range 4 East boundary line to the Northwest corner of Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 4 East; continuing East along the Northern edge of Section 6 to the Southwest corner of Section 32, Township 6 North, Range 4 East; continuing North 1 mile along the Western edge of Section 32 to the Forest boundary; continuing East, then South, then East along the Forest Boundary to the intersection of Forest Road #364 (Grimes Creek Road), located on the Northern edge of Section 3, Township 5 North, Range 4 East; continuing Southwesterly along (not including) Forest Road #364 to the road's intersection with Grimes Creek, located at Township 5 North, Range 4 East, Section 10; continuing Southwesterly along (not including) Grimes Creek back to the point of origin.

The above described area (including all National Forest System Roads and Trails within the area) is shown on the attached map and located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Idaho City Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Mack Fire). This area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
4. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this order.
