**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **IMMEDIATELY**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

**1. Going into or being upon an area.** [Title 36 CFR 261.52 (e)].

**Beginning** at the intersection of the Lochsa River and Walton Creek in section 34, T37N, R14E, Boise Meridian, then **southerly** up Walton Creek to Walton Lake, then **westerly** to the Wilderness boundary where it intersects sections 28 and 29, then **westerly** along the Wilderness boundary to Warm Springs Trail 49, then **northerly** along Trail 49 to junction of Warm Springs Stock Bypass Trail 49-A; then **northerly** along Trail 49-A to the Lochsa River; then **easterly** along the Lochsa River to Walton Creek, the point of beginning.

**2. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof.** [Title 36 CFR 261.58 (b)].

**Wendover Campground:** Entirety, T37N, R13E, S35

**Powell Campground:** Entirety, T37N, R14E, S32

**Whitehouse Campground:** Entirety, T37N, R13E, S36


**White Sand Campground:** Entirety, T37N, R14E, S34

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Lochsa District Ranger as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Western Pacific Timber Company, accessing their private property.


**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are promulgated for **PUBLIC SAFETY** during the management of wildland fires occurring in the area.

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)


