**AREA CLOSURE

For Public Safety**

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on all lands as described in this order, within the Idaho City and Mountain Home Ranger Districts, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the area as described in this order. **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:


1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

The Walker Fire Closure Area is described as all National Forest System (NFS) lands (including all roads and trails within the area) within the following boundary - beginning at the Junction of Idaho State Highway 21 and Grimes Creek Road (aka Forest Road 364) located in Township 5 North, Range 4 East, Section 35, then continuing Northwesterly along, **but not including** Grimes Creek Road #364 to the road's junction with NFS Road #366 (Pine Creek Road); continuing Northwesterly along, **but not including**, NFS Road #366 to the NFS Road #374 (Boise Ridge Road); continuing Northerly along, **but not including**, NFS Road #374 to the Boise National Forest Boundary, located on the Northern line of Section 30, Township 6 North, Range 4 East; continuing Easterly along the Boise National Forest Boundary to the boundary's intersection with Forest Road #307 (Centerville Road), located in Township 6 North, Range 5 East, Section 21; continuing Easterly along, **but not including**, Centerville Road #307 to Montgomery Street (in Idaho City); continuing Southerly along Montgomery Street to Idaho State Highway 21; Continuing Southwesterly along, **but not including**, Idaho State Highway 21 back to the point of origin.

The above described Area (including all roads and trails within the Area) are located on National Forest System lands within the administrative and proclaimed boundaries of the Idaho City and Mountain Home Ranger Districts, Boise National Forest, Boise County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

PURPOSE:

The area as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Walker Fire). This area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
4. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. 16 U.S.C. §551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3571(b)(6), 3581 (b)(7).
5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the areas (and/or roads, trails) covered by this Order.
