Forest Order

Occupancy and Use on National Forest System Lands

Trail Closure

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act(s) below are prohibited in the area displayed on the attached map within the Bonners Ferry Ranger District of the Idaho Panhandle National Forests.

Being on or using the following trails within T64N, R1W Sections 7 (PB38), 8 and 18 (PB41), and T64N R2W Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 24, 25 and 27.

When provided in an order, 36 CFR 261.53 (e) and 36 CFR 261.55 (a), it is prohibited to go into or be upon any area (trail) which is closed for the protection of public health or safety.

This closure is necessary for public safety due to Wildland Fire activity that has occurred. This closure becomes effective on Thursday, August 6, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked. This closure order revokes previous closure Order No. 01-04-07-15-001.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e) the following individuals are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
