Forest Order No. 01-04-02-15-005

National Forest System Area Closure

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter II, Part 261, Subpart B, Section 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the St. Joe Ranger District within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests:

Being on or using the following area (National Forest System lands) within Breezy Chicadee Closure Area:

Being in the Breezy Chicadee Closure Area is defined by National Forest System lands located within the following boundaries (36 CFR 261.52(e)):

The portion of the St. Joe Ranger District beginning at the junction of Forest Service (FS) Road 301 and the St. Joe River, then east along the St. Joe River to its junction with FS road 303 (Beaver Creek Road), then west on the FS road 303 to its junction with FS road 201, then north and west along FS road 201 to the junction with Louis Creek (Snow Peak Wildlife Management Area), then southwest and south along the Snow Peak Wildlife Management Area boundary to its junction with the Mallard Larkins Pioneer Area, the south along the Mallard Larkins Pioneer Area boundary to the boundary with the Clearwater National Forest, then southwest along the Clearwater National Forest Boundary to the boundary with Idaho Department of Lands and St. Joe Ranger District, then north and west along the St Joe Ranger District boundary to the section corner of T. 43 N., R. 5 E., sections 31 and 32 and T. 42 N., R. 5 E., sections 5 and 6, then due north to junction of FS roads 301 and 457, then north along FS road 301 to the point of beginning.

Being on the following Forest Roads (36 CFR 261.54(e)):

All Forest Service roads within the Breezy Chicadee Closure Area are closed including the perimeter road of #301 and #201.

Being on Forest Trails (36 CFR 261.55(a)):

All Forest Service trails within the Breezy Chicadee Closure Area are closed.

Being in developed recreation sites (36 CFR 261.58(b)):

Little North Fork Campground, Trail 50 Trailhead, Round Top Now Hut, Mammoth Springs Campground.

This restriction is in addition to those stated in Subpart A, 36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 261 and becomes effective August 29, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

This restriction is necessary for the protection of public health and safety during (36 CFR 261.53(e)) Wildfire Activity.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following individuals are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission;
2. Owners or lessees of land in the area;
3. Residents in the area;
4. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
