**ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(b) the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest Service Roads and Trails, as shown on the attached map, within the Nez Perce-Clearwater National Forests. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective **immediately**, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

1. **Being on the road.** Title 36 CFR 261.54(e).
2. **Being on the trail.** Title 36 CFR 261.55 (a).
3. **When provided by an order, it is prohibited to go into or be upon an area which is closed for the protection of: Public health and safety.** Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)

**FS TRAIL 45:** From the Trailhead at the junction Road 358 to the junction of Trail 30. [T35N R14E Sec 27, Boise Meridian]

**FS TRAIL 30:** Entirety. [T35N R14E Sec 16, Boise Meridian]


**FS Road 358:** Entirety. [T35N R15E Sec 18, Boise Meridian]

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official emergency duty. Report all emergency access to the Lochsa District Ranger as soon as possible.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**RATIONALE:** This emergency closure is promulgated for **PUBLIC HEALTH and SAFETY** during the management of **wildland fires occurring in the area.**

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office, each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
