WEISER COMPLEX FIRE AREA CLOSURE
(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on the area and road as described in this order, all within administrative boundaries of the Weiser Ranger District, Payette National Forest until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the Fire Area (as described below). **36 CFR 261.52(e)**

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA AND TRAILS DESCRIBED:

Weiser Complex Fire Area (including all roads and trails within the area) is described as including all National Forest System (NFS) Lands within the area beginning at SW corner of Section 35, Township 14 North, Range 6 West; continuing East along the Payette National Forest Boundary to NFS Road 1884 (Jenkins Creek Road); continuing Northerly along (and including) NFS Road 1884 to the junction of NFS Roads 1884 and 322; continuing Northerly along (and including) NFS Road 322 to the junction of NFS Roads 322 and 025 (Adams Creek Road) located in Township 14 North, Range 6 West, Section 23; continuing generally North (Northwest, then North, then East) along (and including) NFS Road 025 to the junction of NFS Roads 025 and 007, located in Township 14 North, Range 6 West, Section 24; then Southeasterly along (and including) NFS Road 007 to the junction of NFS Road 007 and NFS Trail 281 (Stacy Creek Trail) located in Township 14 North, Range 5 West, Section 30; continuing Southeasterly along (and including) NFS Trail 281 to the junction of NFS Trail 281 and NFS Road 009 (Mann Creek Road), located in Township 14 North, Range 5 West, Section 33; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Road 009 to the junction of NFS Roads 009 and 024 (Fourth of July Creek Road), located in Township 14 North, Range 5 West, Section 33; continuing along (but excluding) NFS Road 024 to the junction of NFS Roads 024 and 019 (Bear Creek Saddle Road), located in Township 14 North, Range 5 West, Section 17; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Road 019 to the Northwest Quarter of Section 5, Township 14 North, Range 5 West at the intersection of NFS Road 019 and Bear Creek; continuing Northerly approximately 2 ½ miles along the ridgeline to the intersection of the ridgeline and the North edge of Section 29,

Township 15 North, Range 5 West; continuing East along the Northern edge of Section 29, Township 15 North, Range 5 West to the intersection of the Section boundary and Mann Creek; then continuing Southerly along Mann Creek to the intersection of Mann Creek and NFS Road 009 (Mann Creek Road) located in Township 15 North, Range 5 West, Section 29; continuing generally East (Southeast, then North, then East, then North) along, but excluding NFS Road 009 to Sturgill Peak/Sturgill Fire Lookout located in Township 15 North, Range 5 West, Section 21; continuing Westerly along the ridgeline/grazing allotment fenceline to the intersection of this ridgeline and NFS Trail 268 (Sturgill Peak Trail); continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Trail 268 to the junction of NFS Trail 268 and NFS Road 1005; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Road 1005 to the junction of NFS Roads 1005 and 1878; continuing Northerly along (but excluding) NFS Road 1878 to the junction of NFS Roads 1878 and 030, located in Township 15 North, Range 5 West, Section 9; continuing Southerly, then Northwesterly along (but excluding) NFS Road 030 to the junction of NFS Roads 030 and 085; continuing Northeasterly along (but excluding) NFS Road 085 to the Payette National Forest boundary located in Township 16 North, Range 5 West, Section 24; continuing West and then South along the Payette National Forest to the point of origin in Section 35, Township 14 North, Range 6 West.

The above area (including all roads and trails within the area) are located within the Weiser Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Washington County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.


PURPOSE:

The area (including all trails and roads within the area) as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Weiser Complex Fire Incident). The area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. A map identifying the closure area is attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
