*WEISER COMPLEX FIRE AREA CLOSURE ~ Version #3  
(For Public Safety)*

**PROHIBITIONS:**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) the following acts are prohibited on the lands as described in this order, all within administrative boundaries of the Weiser Ranger District, Payette National Forest until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon the Fire Area (as described below). **36 CFR 261.52(e)**
2. Going onto or being upon the road (as described below). **36 CFR 261.54(e)**.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**AREA CLOSURE DESCRIBED:**

**Weiser Complex Fire Area** (including all roads and trails within the area) is described as including all National Forest System (NFS) Lands within the area beginning at the intersection of the Raft Fire burned area perimeter and The Payette National Forest boundary in Township 15 North, Range 6 West, Section 35; continuing Northeasterly, then Northerly, Then Northwesterly along the Raft Fire burned area perimeter to the intersection of the fire Raft Fire perimeter and the Payette National Forest boundary in Township 15 North, Range 5 West, Section 7; then continuing Southwesterly along the Payette National Forest Boundary to the point of origin in Township 15 North, Range 6 West, Section 35; and also including all NFS Lands within the area beginning at the intersection of the Raft Fire burned area perimeter and The Payette National Forest boundary on the West edge of Township 16 North, Range 6 West, Section 25; continuing Northeasterly along the Raft Fire burned area perimeter to the intersection of the Raft Fire perimeter and the Payette National Forest boundary on the North edge of Township 16 North, Range 6 West, Section 25; then continuing West, then South along the Payette National Forest Boundary to the point of origin in Township 16 North, Range 6 West, Section 25.

The above area (including all roads and trails within the area) are located within the Weiser Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Washington County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

**ROAD CLOSURE DESCRIBED:**

Forest Road #011 (Sturgill Creek Road), from its intersection with the Payette National Forest boundary in Township 15 North, Range 6 West, Section 14, continuing Southeast to the intersection of NFS Road 011 and NFS Road 1651 in Township 15 North, Range 6 West, Section 36.

The above road is located within the Weiser Ranger District, Payette National Forest, Washington County, Idaho, Boise Meridian.

**PURPOSE:**

The area (including all trails and roads within the area) as described above has ongoing wildfire activity (Weiser Complex Fire Incident). The area is closed for public safety and protection from hazards associated with wildfire.

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

1. This Order will be in effect beginning **September 14, 2013 at 6:00 AM** and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Maps identifying the closure area are attached and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
