


The Payette National Forest, Krassel Ranger District, is planning to conduct prescribed burning on the Four Mile, Bald Hill, and Krassel Administration Site Prescribed Fire projects this spring. Maps of the project areas can be found below. Units may be broken into smaller portions to aid in implementation. Timing will be dependent on weather; ignitions will most likely occur sometime between March and May 2021. Ignitions should take 1-3 days for each project, with smoke and fire most likely present in the project area until the next significant precipitation.

East Zone






Spring Burning 2021 Bald Hill






Spring Burning 2021 4 mile
