Remarks:

Firefighter and public safety is the number one priority. The speed limit along Highway 93 near the ICP has been lowered to 45 mph. Please slow down and watch for fire personnel and equipment entering and exiting the roadway in this area.

Today's plan of action is to continue to construct direct line where fire behavior, terrain and other hazards allows for minimal exposure to crews. Continue scouting for locations for contingency lines to the southwest and northwest of the fire's current location. Continue structure assessment and preparation along 4th of July creek and Kriley creek as a precaution.

Weather conditions will be dry and with temperatures around 76 degrees. Winds will be slightly higher today coming out of the southwest at 10 to 24 mph.

There was a Community Meeting last night at the Idaho Fish and Game office while the numbers were low the interest was high.
