.DISCUSSION...

HIGH PRESSURE WILL REMAIN OVER THE WILDFIRE DURING THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS. DAYTIME TEMPERATURES WILL STEADILY WARM DURING THIS TIME...AS DAYTIME HUMIDITY STEADILY DROPS BELOW 20 PERCENT. OVERNIGHT HUMIDITY RECOVERIES WILL ALSO SLOWLY WORSEN OVER TIME...STRUGGLING TO MOISTEN ABOVE 50 PERCENT. WIND IS UNLIKELY TO BE SIGNIFICANT DURING THE NEXT FEW DAYS AS WELL.
