.DISCUSSION...

HIGH PRESSURE WILL CONTINUE TO BE PRESENT NEAR THE WILDFIRE DURING THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS. DAYTIME TEMPERATURES WILL REMAIN WARM... WHILE DAYTIME HUMIDITY CONTINUES TO DROP INTO THE TEENS. OVERNIGHT HUMIDITY RECOVERY WILL BE POOR...PARTICULARLY AT HIGH ELEVATIONS OF THE FIRE. WEST WINDS WILL REMAIN FAIRLY LIGHT DURING EACH DAYTIME AS WELL.
