TRAIL CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (b), the following act(s) are prohibited on the Gardiner and Yellowstone Ranger Districts of the Gallatin National Forest.

1. Being on National Forest System Trails 279, 64 and 60 as depicted on Attachment A of this order. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Forest Order is effective immediately.
