Order No. 01-11-04-13-05

AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 36 CFR Section 261.50 (a) and (b), the following act(s) are prohibited within the area depicted in Attachment A of this order and on the listed National Forest System Road within the Gardiner and Yellowstone Ranger Districts of the Gallatin National Forest.

1. Going into or being upon an area which is closed for public health or safety. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
2. Being on National Forest System Roads #2596 and #348 36 CFR 261.54(e)
3. Being on National Forest System Trail #78 and #60 and part of #64 as depicted on Attachment A 36 CFR 261.55(a)

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty;

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This Forest Order is effective immediately.

This Forest Order rescinds order number 01-11-04-13-03 and 01-11-04-13-04.
