FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited as described below within the Ninemile Ranger District of the Lolo National Forest. This restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, and becomes effective upon signing and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR – National Forest System Roads

It is prohibited to be on the road [36 CFR 261.54(e)].

The closure cited in this order is to protect the public from unsafe road conditions as a result of the Butler Creek Fire.

Description of Closed Road:

Butler Creek Loop Area:

Kennedy Ridge Road, National Forest System Road (NFSR) #5507, shall be closed from the junction with Butler Creek Loop Road #456 near the creek crossing to the end of the road.

Stoney Creek Road, NFSR #2178, shall be closed at the junction with Butler Creek Loop Road #456 to the end of the road.

Edith Peak Road Area:

Butler Ridge Road, NFSR #5548 shall be closed at the junction with Edith Pead Road NFSR #476-1 to the end of the road.

Pole Road, NFSR #17215 shall be closed at the junction with Edith Pead Road NFSR #476-1 to the end of the road.

Phillips Road, NFSR #16441 shall be closed at the junction with Edith Pead Road NFSR #476-1 to the end of the road.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit issued by a forest officer specifically authorizing the prohibited act;
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty
