
Fire crews work on control lines, hot spots in Muddy Creek 2 Fire

Significant advances were made yesterday in improving control lines and dealing with hot spots in the Muddy Creek 2 Fire burning on the Northern Cheyenne Reservation.

The fire was originally reported on July 25, roughly five miles southwest of Lame Deer. The lightning caused blaze is currently estimated at 2,978 acres and 35-percent containment. 216 personnel are assigned to the effort and are led by a Type II Incident Management Team.

Officials are expected increased fire activity as the temperature rises and fuels dry out.
