

Fire Activity : Fire has grown to 500 Acres.

Weather and smoke conditions: With the North winds predicted today, smoke could drift southwest across HWY 64 and possibly into the Shooting Creek community today, tonight and through tomorrow. The smoke concentrations could increase from the GOOD levels to the Moderate levels in that area.

You can reduce your smoke exposure: The information below is intended to help people, where possible, to reduce and minimize their exposure to smoke by avoiding the worst times of day and timing their activities to the best times of day.

Monitoring: We have 3 portable smoke monitors deployed near the wildfire. Shooting Creek, NC: approx. 1.5 miles SSW of the fire; Franklin, NC: approx. 16 miles NE and Andrews, NC: 13 miles NW of the fire.
