**Carson City, Nev. – July 25, 2016** - The Little Den Fire started at approximately 10:30 a.m., on Wednesday, July 20. The fire is burning approximately 45 miles southwest of Austin, NV in juniper trees and grass. Fire investigators have confirmed the fire is human caused.

The fire burned in pinion-juniper with stands of grass and sagebrush. Fire crews are progressing with mopping up 50-100 feet from the fires edge and are completing rehabilitation of the fire area. The only smoke remaining is interior sections of unburned vegetation which are far from the fire line and pose no threat. Little threat remains to sage grouse habitat.

With the fires containment at 100% this will be the final update unless activity increases on the Little Den Fire.

Nevada Type 3 Incident Management Team (IMT), led by Incident Commander Tyler Hecht, took over operations of the Little Den Wildfire on Friday morning, July 22 at 6:00 a.m. For further information go to <http://inciweb.nwcg.gov/incident/4875/>
