Eagle 2 Wildfire Area Closure

A. PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, roads, and trails as described in this order, in the Bridgeport Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest until this order is rescinded.

It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of:

Public Health or Safety,
[36 CFR 261.53(e)]

Being on the road,
[36 CFR 261.54(e)]

Being on the trail
[36 CFR 261.55(a)]

B. EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following is exempt from this order.

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

C. AREA DESCRIBED

CLOSED areas include: Eagle 2 burn and adjacent areas as depicted on Exhibit A, Map, on the Bridgeport Ranger District, Humboldt-Toiyabe National Forest, including roads and trails within the burned area. Also included are the Buckeye Campground, Buckeye Campground Road, and portions of the Eagle Creek and Buckeye trails. These areas are closed until further notice.

The Forest Service closure includes the following:

Identified Area: T4N, R24E, Sections 5,6,7,8
Roads and trails: FSR32160, Trail066 and Trail068.

D. PURPOSE


The purpose of this order is to protect public health and safety in affected wild land fire areas.

E. IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Special Order implementing Road Closure Restrictions is effective on Saturday, August 15, 2015 at 8 A.M. and shall remain in effect until rescinded.
2. Exhibit A, Map and Exhibit B, Definitions are attached and incorporated into this ORDER.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a class B misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization and/or imprisonment of not more than 6 months [Title 16 USC 551. 18USC 3571 (b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)]

EXHIBIT B

DEFINITIONS

Area Closure

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROAD: Means forest roads other than a road which has been authorized by a legally documented right-of-way held by a State, county or other local public road authority.

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM TRAIL: Means forest trails other than a trail which has been authorized by a legally documented right-of-way held by a State, county or other local public road authority.

DESIGNATED AREA: A geographic area defined by an agency in which specific land use activity is occurring.

DESIGNATED ROADS AND TRAILS: Those forest development roads and trails which are identified and/or otherwise described on maps regularly provided to the public by Land Management agencies.

MOTOR VEHICLE: Means any vehicle which is self-propelled, other than:

- (1) A vehicle operated on rails; and
- (2) Any wheelchair or mobility device, including one that is battery-powered, that is designed solely for use by a mobility-impaired person for locomotion and that is suitable for use in an indoor pedestrian area.

For further definitions or clarification of definitions, refer to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations 261.2
