Temporary closure of public lands in Malheur County, Oregon Lifted

Agency: Bureau of Land Management

Action: Emergency closure dated August 10, 2012 has been rescinded

Bureau of Land Management Vale District- The emergency closure dated August 10, 2012 **has been rescinded**. The fire activity on the Holloway fire is minimal and it has been determine that the land closure is no longer needed for public safety. However, the fire protection orders are still in effect for those lands. No off road travel, no campfires, no smoking, and a shovel / fire extinguisher are required in the vehicle.

Description of the Closure Area:

Vale BLM District Boundary near Trout Creek Canyon (T38S R38E Sec. 2 where Whitehorse Road crosses Little Trout Creek), all BLM lands south of the Whitehorse Road to the Nevada State boundary, all BLM lands west of Highway 95 to the Vale BLM District Boundary, T41S R37E Sec.23 (geographic feature, Sherman Fields to the Trout Creek Canyon).
