

WILDFIRE CLOSURE

**MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST
HOOD RIVER AND BARLOW RANGER DISTRICTS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b) and effective 0900 on September 4, 2013 the following acts are prohibited in the area described in Attachment A of this order on the Mt. Hood National Forest. The closure area is defined as the area of Mt. Hood National Forest surrounding the perimeter and interior of the Government Flats Fire and associated roads with heavy fire traffic.

This Forest Order is in effect until rescinded.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
4. Any Federal, State or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
