

**TEMPORARY AREA AND USE RESTRICTIONS**

**FREMONT-WINEMA NATIONAL FOREST**

**Pursuant to 16 USC, Title 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)**, the following special restrictions and prohibitions are established on all Forest roads, trails, and within the specific area on the Fremont-Winema National Forest, Klamath Ranger District, in the State of Oregon where signed on the ground and contained within the boundary lines described as follows and depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated in this Order as 'ATTACHMENT A.'

**CLOSURE AREA BOUNDARY**

- Beginning at the intersection of the south boundary of the Sky Lakes Wilderness and Forest Trail 3759 (*Badger Lake Trail*), thence in a counter-clockwise direction along the east boundary of the Sky Lakes Wilderness to its intersection with the Forest Trail 3712 (*Lost Lake Trail*), thence west along the Forest Trail 3712 to its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail, thence southerly along the Pacific Crest Trail to its intersection with Forest Trail 993 (*Twin Ponds Trail*), thence easterly along Forest Trail 993 to its intersection with the Twin Ponds Trail Head and Forest Road 3661 at Four Mile Lake Campground, thence east along Forest road 3661 and 3661-560 through Four Mile Lake Campground to its intersection with Forest Trail 3759, thence northerly along Forest Trail 3759 to the beginning.

**CLOSED ROADS AND TRAILS**

- Forest Road 3661 from its intersection with Forest Road 3661-360 to Four Mile Lake Campground.
- Forest Trail 993 (*Twin Ponds Trail*), from its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail to its intersection with Forest Road 3661 at Four Mile Lake Campground.
- Forest Trail 3759 (*Badger Lake Trail*), from its intersection with Forest Road 3661-560 to its intersection with south boundary of the Sky Lakes Wilderness.
- Forest Trail 3712 (*Lost Lake Trail*), from its intersection with the Sky Creek Wilderness boundary to its intersection with the Pacific Crest Trail.
- Four Mile Lake Campground is closed.

**PROHIBITIONS**

**It is prohibited to go into or be upon any of the above described lands which are closed for the protection of public health and safety, including all National Forest System roads and trails therein. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)**

**Being on a forest system road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e)**

**Being on a forest system trail. 36 CFR § 261.55(a)**

This restriction is in addition to those prohibitions enumerated in Subpart A of 36 CFR§261 and any other special restrictions pertaining to the described lands.

## EXEMPTIONS

**Pursuant to 36 CFR§261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:**

1. Personnel with written authorization by a Forest Officer, which specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act. The issuing Officer may include such conditions as are considered necessary for the protection of the area, or for the promotion of the health, safety, or welfare of its users.
2. Any Federal, State, or local Officer or volunteer in the performance of an official duty.
3. Persons under a special use authorization that allows the otherwise prohibited action, and approved contractors and their agents directly engaged in approved work outlined in an operating plan or permit.
4. Persons travelling along the affected portions of the Pacific Crest Trail shown on Attachment A, providing those persons do not depart from the Pacific Crest Trail into the closure area.

*'Person' means natural person, corporation, company, partnership, trust, firm, or association of persons. 'Permit' means authorization in writing by a Forest Officer. 'Forest Officer' means an employee of the Forest Service.*

**This closure is enacted due to firefighting activities taking place within the closure area, and for the protection of public and employee safety.**

This Order becomes effective at 10:00 AM, July 28, 2014, and will remain in force until rescinded.


