### South Fork Complex Fire Closure

#### ORDER NO. T-2014-0604-MAL-16

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the areas and National Forest System roads described in this order within the Malheur National Forest beginning 0001, September 26, 2014, until further notice.

1. Going into or being upon an area. For the purpose of this order, this prohibition applies to persons going into or being upon the areas described in Appendix A of this order (36 CFR 261.52(e)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

**APPENDIX A**

**Area Descriptions:**

**South Fork Complex Fire**

That area lying within the following perimeters:

Road Closure:

- FSR 24 west of the intersection of FSR 24 and 270 is closed

Area Closure:

- Starting at the western Malheur National Forest (MNF) boundary at Township 14s Range 27e and Section 4 to the junction with Forest Service Road (FSR) 2150
- Along FSR 2150 to its junction with FSR 070
- FSR 070 to its junction with FSR 2170
- FSR 2170 to its junction with FSR 2490
- FSR 2490 to its junction with FSR 24
- FSR 24 westerly to the western MNF boundary
- Northerly along the western MNF boundary to T14s R27e Sec. 4

**Assessment of Need and Enforcement Plan**
