

SPECIAL CLOSURE

MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, 261.50(a), and effective immediately the following act is prohibited until further notice, on the area described in Exhibit A of this order within the Mt. Hood National Forest, Marion and Clackamas Counties, Oregon.

- (1) Going into or being upon the area. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

Area description is defined by: the Elk Lake Trail #559 on the east, the Pansy Trail #558 trail on the southwest, the Dickey Creek Trail on the west, and the Collawash River on the northeast.

- (2) Being on a closed trail (36 CFR 261.55 (a))
- Elk Creek Trail #559 from Forest Road 6380 to the intersection with Trail #558.
 - Mother Lode Trail #558 from its junction Trail #559 north to Big Slide Lake.
 - Dickey Creek Trail #553 from its beginning at Forest Road 6340-032 to Big Slide Lake.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
