

FIRE CLOSURE
Bull of the Woods Area

MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST and
WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, 261.50(a) and (b), and effective immediately, the area depicted in "Attachment A" on the Mt. Hood and Willamette National Forests is closed to entry. Forest Road 6380 from FR63 to its terminus is closed. Trail 559 from the Elk Lake Creek Trailhead to the junction of Trail 544 west of Elk Lake is closed. Trail 558 from the Mother Lode Trailhead to the junction of Trail 559 is closed. Bagby Hot Springs and Pegleg Falls Recreation Areas are open to the public. These prohibitions shall be in effect until rescinded.



This Order supersedes Order No. MH-2010-04




