

**FOREST ORDER**

**WILDFIRE CLOSURE**

**MT. HOOD NATIONAL FOREST**

**Hood River and Zigzag Ranger Districts**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261(b) and effective immediately the following acts are prohibited until further notice, on the area depicted in Attachment A and described in Attachment B of this order within the Mt. Hood National Forest, Hood River and Clackamas Counties, Oregon.

1. Going into or being upon the area. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
2. Being on a road 36 CFR 261.54(e)
3. Being on a closed trail 36 CFR 261.55 (a).

This Forest Order is in effect until October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011 or until rescinded.

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- a. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- b. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**ATTACHMENT B: Description**

Forest Road 18 North of Lolo Pass, Forest Roads 1810, 16, 2840, 3511, and 3512, are closed and all other National Forest System Roads as depicted on the attached map.

The following campgrounds are closed: Kinnikinnick, TillyJane, and Cloud Cap.

The following major trails are closed:

- Yokum Ridge #771
- Mazamas Trail #625
- Vista Ridge Trail #626,
- Elk Cove Trail #631
- Pinnacle Ridge Trail #630;
- Trail #600 from Gnarl Ridge Trail #652 northwest to its terminus at Ramona Falls Trail #797; and
- All minor trails depicted within the closure area Attachment A.
