**EMERGENCY FIRE AREA CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon general forest areas within the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning September 28, 2020 at 12:00 Noon and ending December 15, 2020 unless rescinded sooner.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Being upon a closed road. [36 CFR § 261.54 (e)]
2. Going into or being upon a closed area. [36 CFR § 261.52 (e)]
3. Being upon a closed trail. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]

**Closure Area** is described as an area starting at the point where the Umpqua National Forest boundary intersects Forest Road 23 in section 36, T. 25 S., R. 1 W., and continuing in a southeast direction along Forest Road 23 to the point Forest Road 23 junctions with Forest Road 38, then southwesterly along Forest Road 38 to the point it changes jurisdiction and becomes County Road 249, then continues southwesterly along County Road 249 to the junction of State Highway 138, then down State Highway 138 to the southeast to the junction of Forest Road 4714, then continues southwest along Forest Road 4714 to the junction of Forest Road 4720, then continues in a generally southerly direction along Forest Road 4720 to the junction of Forest Road 2715, then continues in a generally southern direction along Forest Road 2715 to the junction of Forest Road 27, then in a generally westerly direction to the point where Forest Road 27 changes jurisdiction at start of County Road 17, then continuing along County Road 17 in a generally northwest direction to the Forest Boundary in Section 12, T. 27 S., R. 2 W., then following the Forest Boundary in a north and easterly direction back to the point of origin. The forest routes listed above that bound the closure area and all Forest Service lands, roads, and trails within the described closure are hereby made part of this closure order.

**Exceptions to the closure:**

Forest Road 27, Little River Road will remain open to public travel.  
Forest Road 38, Steamboat Road will remain open to public travel.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Roseburg, Oregon this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September 2020.

This Order supersedes Order No. 06-15-03-20-421 beginning September 28, 2020 at 12:00 Noon.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
