EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE - CHETCO BAR FIRE

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited upon Gold Beach and Wild Rivers Ranger Districts within the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning August 20, 2017 and ending December 31, 2017, unless sooner rescinded.

PROHIBITION:

- 1) **Going onto or being within an area closed for public health and safety. [36 CFR § 261.53(e)]**

AREA CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:

The Chetco Bar Fire Area Closure is described as beginning at the Winchuck River road (FSR1107) and heading north along the National Forest boundary to the junction of FSR3680, east to the Game Lake Trail (FST1174), continuing east to the Illinois river and following the river to the eastern boundary of the Kalmiopsis Wilderness. It then heads south to FSR 1107-220 and then west back to FSR1107.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18USC § 3571).
