EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

Pursuant to 36 CFR Part 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited within the Diamond Lake Ranger District of the Umpqua National Forest, as described below and shown on attached Exhibit A. The order will become effective upon signature and will remain in effect until rescinded.

**Area Closure is as follows:**

The area closure includes all roads and trails within the closed area and roads described below, as shown on Exhibit A:

**Closed Area:**

Beginning at FS Road 2610, known as Birds Point Road and the junction of FS Road 2612, following northerly to the junction with FS Road 2154 and the boundary of the Umpqua National Forest; following the forest boundary easterly along FS Road 2154 to the junction of FS Road 770; following FS Road 770 south to the junction of FS Road 700; following FS Road 700 southeast to the junction of FS Road 60, known as Windigo Pass Road; following FS Road 60 southwest to the junction of FS Road 2612; following FS Road 2612 westerly to the junction of FS Road 2610, the beginning.

**Open Roads:**

Roads open for public travel are described as, beginning at FS Road 60 from the junction of FS Road 2612 to junction of FS Road 700 continuing on FS Road 700 to junction of FS Road 770, continuing on FS Road 770 to junction of FS Road 2154.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, State or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 2) Owners or lessees of land within the affected area.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
