Trail Closure due to Current Fire Activity

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following act is prohibited on Trail No. 1552 within the Diamond Lake Ranger District on the Umpqua National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning on July 11, 2018 and ending September 31, 2018.

PROHIBITION:

1. Being on a trail closed for the protection of public safety. [36 CFR § 261.55(a)]

TRAIL CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:

Diamond Ranger District Trail No. 1552 from the intersection with Spring Creek (T. 25 ½ S, R. 3E, Sec. 32 to the intersection with NFS Road No. 3810 (T. 25 S, R. 3 E, Sec. 17).

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

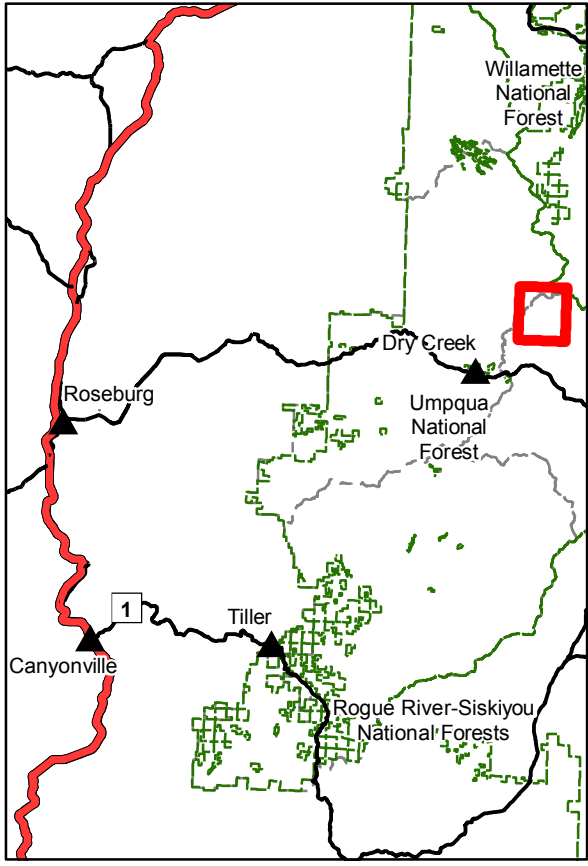
1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Pacificorp employees in the performance of their official duties.
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A. Executed in Roseburg, Oregon this 11th day of July, 2018.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18USC § 3571).
