ORDER # WIL- 18-2009-03-06**

EMERGENCY CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area, and on roads and trails described in this order within the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective September 5, 2009 at 0600 am, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

- (1) Being in an area closed for public health and safety.**
§36 CFR 261.52(e)
- (2) Being on a road closed for public health and safety.**
§36 CFR 261.54(e)
- (3) Being on a trail closed for public health and safety.**
§36 CFR 261.55(a)


Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.**
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or Firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.**
- (3) Owners or Lessees of land within the affected area.**

DESCRIPTION OF THE AFFECTED AREA:

- Bounded on the north by the 640 spur of Forest Service road 2212.
- Bounded on the west by the Forest Boundary and Forest Service road 1131.
- Bounded on the south by the west jct. of Forest Service road 1133 to north jct. of Forest Service road 1155.
- All area closed west of Forest Service road 2212 between the 640 spur and the jct. of forest service road 1155.



