



ORDER 18-2014-10-18

EMERGENCY CLOSURE FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY

WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST
Middle Fork Ranger District

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in the area, and on roads and trails described in this order within the Willamette National Forest. This order will become effective upon signature, and will remain in effect until rescinded.

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR §261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or lessees of land within the affected area.
 - For the purpose of accessing their lands within the affected area.
- (4) Residents or their visitors within the affected area.
 - For the purpose of accessing their private residences within the affected area.

DESCRIPTION OF AREA:

The order applies to the area described below, on the Middle Fork Ranger District, Willamette National Forest.

- Beginning at the junction of Highway 58 and Forest Road 5840, east on Highway 58 to the junction of Highway 58 and Forest Road 5882 (LaDuke Road).
- East on Forest Road 5882 (LaDuke Road) to the junction of Forest Roads 5882 and 2100.
- South on Forest Road 2100 to the junction of Forest Roads 2100 and 2102.
- West on Forest Road 2102 to the junction of Forest Roads 2102 and 2102-425.
- West on Forest Road 2102-425 to the boundary of the Umpqua and Willamette National Forests.
- Northwest along the Boundary of the Umpqua and the Willamette National Forests to its intersection with Forest Road 5840.
- North on Forest Road 5840 to the junction of Forest Road 5840 and Highway 58, point of beginning.

The following roads and trails are affected by this closure:

- Forest Road 1700 will remain **open** to the public.
- Forest Road 5852 (LaDuke Road) will remain **open** to the public.
- Forest Road 2100 will remain **open** to the public
- Forest Road 2102 will remain **open** to the public.
- Trail 3607 (Larison Rock) is **open** to the public.
- Forest Roads 5840 and all of its associated spur roads are **closed** within the affected area.
- Forest Roads 5847 and all of its associated spur roads are **closed** within the affected area.
- Forest Roads 5850 and all of its associated spur roads are **closed** within the affected area.
- Trail 3473 (Lawler) is **closed** to public entry within the affected area.
- Trail 3466 (Deception) is **closed** within the affected area.
- All other roads and trails within the affected area are **closed** to public entry.





Exhibit A: Emergency Closure Order # 18-2014-10-18

TERMINATION OF ORDER 18-2014-10-16

WILLAMETTE NATIONAL FOREST

MIDDLE FORK RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the prohibitions listed in Order 18-2014-04-16 were implemented by Forest Supervisor Meg Mitchell. It was necessary to close the area due to public safety concerns related to the Deception Creek Fire Complex. The order was signed on August 13, 2014, effectively closing portions of the Middle Fork Ranger District to public entry.

A type 1 team has taken over the fire, and has determined that they would like open the Larison Rock Trail (trail 3607) to public entry, and close Forest Road 5840 to public entry. Therefore, Order 18-2014-10-16 is hereby terminated, and is being replaced by order 18-2014-10-18.
