ORDER # 06-18-04-17-13

FOREST ORDER  
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order is effective from July 31, 2017 and be in effect until rescinded or December 1, 2017.

**PROHIBITION:**

**(1) Being on a trail closed for Public Health and Safety**

**36 CFR § 261.55 (a)**

The following trails are closed:

- Whitewater Trail #3429 is closed from its origin at Whitewater Trailhead to the junction with the Pacific Crest Trail #2000.
- Cheat Creek Trail #3441 is closed from its origin at Cheat Creek Trailhead to the junction with the Triangulation Trail #3373.
- Triangulation Trail #3373 is closed from its junction with trail #3374 (near Triangulation Peak) to the terminus at Whitewater Trail #3429.
- Crag Trail #3364 from its origin at Breitenbush Trailhead to the terminus at the Triangulation Trail #3373.
- Pacific Crest Trail (#2000) north of Woodpecker Trail (#3442) to Breitenbush Lake
- South Breitenbush Trail (#3375) east of Bear Point Trail (#3342) up to the PCT (#2000)

**(2) Being on road closed for Public Health and Safety**

**36 CFR § 261.54 (e)**

The following roads are closed:

- Forest Service Road 2243 is closed from its intersection with Highway 22 to its terminus at Whitewater Trailhead.
- Forest Service Road 2243-302 is closed from its junction with Forest Service Road 2243 to its terminus.
- Forest Service Road 2243-440 is closed from its junction with Forest Service Road 2243 to its terminus.
- Forest Service Road 2243-460 is closed from its junction with Forest Service Road 2243 to its terminus.

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR§ 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

ORDER # 06-18-04-17-13

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.
