ORDER # 06-18-01-17-19

FOREST ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order is effective on August 17, 2017 and shall be in effect until rescinded or December 1, 2017.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Entering into or being upon National Forest System lands closed for the protection of public health or safety. 36 CFR § 261.53(e)
2. Being on the road. 36 CFR § 261.54(e)
3. Being on a trail. 36 CFR § 261.55(a)
4. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. 36 CFR § 261.58(b)

AREA DESCRIPTION:

All areas affected by this closure are located within Lane County, Oregon. In Township 16S, Range 5E, Sections 25-36 through 31. In Township 16S, R6E, Sections 26-35. In Township 17S, R5E, Sections 1-12, 15-17, 20-22, 28, 29, 32, 33. In Township 17S, R 6E, Sections 1-18, 20-29, 33. In T17S, R6 ½ E, Sections 9, 16, 21, 28. In Township 18S, R 5E, Sections 2-4, 10-12, 14, 23, 25, 26, 34-36. In Township 18S, R6E, Sections 28-35. In Township 18S, R6 ½ E, Section 33. In Township 19S, Range 5E, Sections 1-3, 11-15, 22-25, 36. In Township 19S, R 5 ½ E, Sections 1-5, 8-17, 20-29, 23-24, 36. In Township 19S, R 6E, Sections 4-9, 16-21, 28-33. In Township 20S, R6E, Sections 4-6.

The closure includes all US Forest Service lands, roads and trails within the boundary described below and as depicted on the attached map and incorporated into this order as "Attachment A".

Beginning where Forest Service Road (FSR) 19 (Aufderheide/West Cascades Scenic Byway) intersects FSR 408 in Township 16S, Range 5E, Section 30, and crossing east over the South Fork of the McKenzie River to the intersection of FSR 436 and FSR 447. Continuing east following the Willamette National Forest boundary (forest boundary) to the intersection of the forest boundary and FSR 480. East along FSR 480, all lands south of FSR 480 but not including FSR 480, to the intersection of FSR 480 and FSR 490. Northeast from the intersection with FSR 490 following the forest boundary to the intersection of the forest boundary and FSR 2639 in Section 24, T16S, R5E. East along FSR 2639, all lands south of FSR 2639 but not including FSR 2639, to the intersection of FSR 2639 and FSR 2638 at Horse Creek Campground. East along FSR 2638, all land south of 2638 and including 2638 but not including Horse Creek Campground, to the forest boundary in Section 29, T16S, R6E. Following the forest boundary to

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the intersection with FSR 2638 in Section 28, T16S, R6E. East along FSR 2638, all lands south of 2638 and including 2638, to the Three Sisters Wilderness Boundary, and the boarder of the Three Sisters Emergency Fire Area Closure (Order # 06-01-17-03), in in Section 1, T17S, R6E. Following along the Three Sisters Wilderness boundary, all lands east and north of the Three Sisters Wilderness boundary, to the east side of the Cougar Reservoir in Section 5, T17S, R5E. Continuing along the Three Sisters Wilderness boundary, all lands west and south of the Three Sisters Wilderness boundary, to the boundary between the Three Sisters Wilderness and the Waldo Lake Wilderness in Section 7 of T20S, R6E. West along the Waldo Lake Wilderness boundary, all lands north of the Waldo Lake Wilderness Boundary, continuing to ½ mile past the wilderness boundary to the intersection of FSR 1944 and FSR 19. North from the intersection of FSR 1944 and FSR 19, all lands east including FSR 19, to the Grasshopper Trail (#3569). North along the Grasshopper Trail, all lands east of the Grasshopper Trail and including the Grasshopper Trail, to the Grasshopper Trailhead on FSR 1927. North along FSR 1927, all lands east of FSR 1927 but not including FSR 1927, to the west bank of the South Fork of the McKenzie River (river). North along the river, and all lands east of the river, to the south end of the Cougar Reservoir and the intersection of FSR 19. North along the west side of FSR 19, all lands east of FSR 19 and including FSR 19, to where FSR Road 19 intersects FSR 408 in T16S, R5E, Section 30.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:


- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or lessees of land in the area.

These restrictions are implemented for the safety of the public, and fire suppression personnel.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subparts A, B and C.

This order supersedes Forest Order #06-18-01-17-16, executed August 8th, 2017.
