**FOREST ORDER
OCCUPANCY AND USE**

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the Foley Ridge Road Closure Area located within the Willamette National Forest. This Order is effective on September 4, 2017 and shall be in effect until rescinded or December 1, 2017, whichever is sooner.

PROHIBITIONS:

FOLEY RIDGE ROAD CLOSURE AREA

All areas affected by this closure are located within Lane County, Oregon. In Township 16S, Range 6E, Sections 15-17, 20-27, 35, 36. In township 16S, Range 7E, Section 31.

The closure includes all US Forest Service roads and trails described below and as depicted on the attached map and incorporated into this order as "Attachment A".

(1) Being on the road. 36 CFR § 261.54 (e).

The following roads are closed:

- Forest Service Road (FSR) 2643 in its entirety from its beginning at Highway 126 and all connected roads accessed exclusively by FSR 2643, as shown in Attachment A
- FSR 410 from the intersection with FSR 2643 to the Willamette National Forest Boundary on the west edge of Section 20 in T16S, R6E

(2) Being on the trail. 36 CFR § 261.55 (a).

The following trails are closed:

- Rainbow Falls Trail # 3543 in its entirety from its beginning at Rainbow Falls Trailhead (and including Rainbow Falls Trailhead)

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Any person with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- (3) Owners or lessees of land in the area.

These restrictions are implemented for the safety of the public, and fire suppression personnel.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR § 261, Subparts A.
