ORDER # 06-18-10-21-32

FOREST ORDER  
OCCUPANCY AND USE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order supersedes order # 06-18-10-21-27. This Order is effective on October 1, 2021, and shall be in effect until June 30, 2022 unless rescinded sooner.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Entering into or being upon an area closed for the protection of public health or safety. **36 CFR § 261.53(e)**
2. Being on the road. **36 CFR § 261.54(e)**
3. Being on a trail. **36 CFR § 261.55(a)**
4. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. **36 CFR § 261.58(b)**

**CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:**

All areas affected by this closure are located within Lane County, Oregon, and within the Administrative Boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. The closure includes all US Forest Service general forest areas, developed recreation sites, dispersed recreation sites, roads, and trails described below and as depicted on the attached map, incorporated into this order as "Exhibit A".

The entire Kwis Fire Closure Areas is in Township 21 S., Range 4 E. The Kwis Fire Closure Area begins at the junction of Forest System Road 24 and the Forest System Road 2400207. The northern closure boundary then follows Forest System Road 24 continuing east until its junction with Forest System Road 2408. At this junction the eastern closure boundary follows and includes 2408 south east to the junction of Forest System Road 5871 in section 4. The eastern closure boundary follows south and includes 5871 to its junction with 5871.328 in section 16. The southern closure boundary follows 5871.328 west along the fire perimeter through section 17 until the junction with Trail Number 3559. It then follows the trail, but does not include it, until it connects with Forest System Road 2400.251 in section 18. The final piece of the southern closure boundary is from 2400.251 to 2400.207 in section 18. The western closure boundary goes from the junction of 2400.251 and follows and includes 2400.207 north all the way to the 24 Road in section 7.

All Forest System Roads within the closure boundary including, but not limited to the following.

**Campground:**

- Salmon Creek Falls

**Dispersed camping areas closed:**

- Any Dispersed Camping within the closure area

**Trails/Trailheads:**

All Trails and trailheads within the closure boundary, including but not limited to the following.

- Forest Trail 4365 – Salmon Creek Trail
- Forest Trail 4366 – South Salmon Creek Trail
- Eugene to Crest Trail System Segments
  - Forest Trail 3559 – Heckletooth (begins at Forest System Road 5871 and the junction of Forest Trail 3559 and goes west to Forest System Road 2400.207.)

**EXEMPTIONS:**

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order) specifically exempting them for this Order;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These restrictions are implemented for the safety of the public.

These prohibitions are in addition to general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subparts A, B and C.

**Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for a corporation or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 U.S.C §§ 3551, 3559, 3571, and 3581.**
