FOREST ORDER

MIDDLE FORK COMPLEX FIRE EMERGENCY AREA CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited in the areas described in this order on National Forest System lands within the administrative boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. This Order supersedes Order #06-18-10-21-29 and is effective October 7, 2021 through June 30, 2022, unless rescinded sooner.

**PROHIBITIONS:**

1. Being on a road. **36 CFR § 261.54(e)**
2. Being on a trail. **36 CFR § 261.55(a)**
3. Entering or using a developed recreation site or portion thereof. **36 CFR § 261.58 (b)**
4. Camping **36 CFR § 261.58 (e)**
5. Entering into or being upon National Forest System Lands closed for the protection of public health or safety. **36 CFR § 261.53(e)**

**CLOSURE DESCRIPTION:**

The closure is contained within the State of Oregon, within Lane County, and within the Administrative Boundaries of the Willamette National Forest. The closure includes the US Forest Service general forest areas, developed recreation sites, roads, and trails encompassed by and including the boundary described below and as depicted on the attached map and incorporated into this order as "Exhibit A".

The Middle Fork Complex Closure Area begins at the junction of Forest Service Roads 18 and 1824. The northern closure boundary then follows and includes FS Road 18 to the junction of FS Roads 18 and 1832, where it continues and includes FS road 1832 to the junction of FS roads 1832 and 2619. The eastern boundary then follows FS road 2619 south to the junction of FS Road 2618 incorporating all land west of FS Road 2619 but does not include FS Road 2619. It then follows FS Road 2618 south and east to the junction of FS road 1933 and incorporates all land to the west of FS Road 2618 but does not include FS Road 2618. It then follows and includes FS Road 1933 south to the junction of FS road 1927. It then follows and includes FS Road 1927 to the junction of FS Road 1926. It then follows and includes FS Road 1926 to the junction of FS road 19. The southern closure boundary follows FS Road 19 to the junction of FS Road 1925 incorporating land north of the FS Road 19 in the closure but does not include FS Road 19 in the closure. It then follows and includes FS Road 1925 to the junction of FS Road 642 and follows and includes FS Road 642 to the junction of FS Road 1912. It then follows and incorporates FS Road 1912

west to the junction of FS Road 1825. The western boundary follows and includes FS Road 1825 north to the junction of FS Road 210. It then follows and includes FS Road 210 north to the junction of FS Road 1824. It then follows and includes FS Road 1824 north to the junction of FS Road 18.

**Trails and Trailheads within Closure:**

Fall Creek Trail, upper section beginning where it crosses Rd 18 at the 1828 junction.  
Gold Point Trailhead and Trail.

**EXEMPTIONS:**


Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

- (1) Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order) specifically exempting them for this Order;
- (2) Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

**Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for a corporation or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.**
