



## Eagle Complex Update Monday, August 31, 2015

**This will be the final update for the Eagle Complex from Rocky Mountain Team Black.**

On Sunday, favorable conditions with temperatures in the low 60s and relative humidity values around 40 percent offered an opportunity for firefighters to make significant progress on mop-up. Most of the fire area received rainfall, though amounts were typically less than one-tenth of an inch. On the western edge of the fire from Boulder Park to Forest Road (FR) 77, crews continued light thinning and placed hose along the length of the road to mitigate any fire impacts in that area. Minimal fire activity was observed along the southern flank from FR 77 east to the East Fork of Eagle Creek. In the East Fork of Eagle Creek and along the eastern edge of the fire to the Eagle Cap Wilderness, firefighters continued to reinforce and strengthen containment lines and mop-up.

On Monday, weather conditions will be in the mid-70s with relative humidity values near 25 percent. The expected weather conditions will minimize fire activity and allow firefighters favorable conditions to continue strengthening containment lines.

At 6 p.m. on Monday, Rocky Mountain Incident Management Team Black will transfer command of the Eagle Complex back to the Wallowa-Whitman National Forest and the Oregon Department of Forestry.
