SPECIAL ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
UINTA-WASATCH-CACHE NATIONAL FOREST
LOGAN RANGER DISTRICT

TEMPORARY AREA, ROAD AND TRAIL CLOSURE

PROHIBITION:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.50(b), **the following acts are prohibited** on the National Forest System trails and area described in this order. The area, roads and trails affected are located within the Logan Ranger District, Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. This order is in effect until further notice

1. **Being in or upon the area, roads and trails** as described below and shown on attached map. This includes all pedestrian, equestrian, bicycle and any type of motorized vehicle. [36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, state or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION:

Area closure including all National Forest System lands and Beaver Creek road (Forest Service road #011), Sink Hollow road (Forest Service road #110) which turns into an ATV trail (Forest Service trail #110) in section 5 and Peterson Hollow trail (Forest Service trail #135) all within the following: Township 15 North, Range 3 East, sections PB 41 and PB 42; Township 15 North, Range 4 East Sections PB 37 and 38; Township 14 North, Range 3 East, Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12; Township 14 North, Range 4 East, Sections 2 and 6; Township 14 North, Range 3 East, Section 10, 13, 14 and 15 (where the Peterson Hollow trail comes down to the Franklin Basin Road), all located within the Salt Lake Base Meridian as shown on the attached map.

PURPOSE:

Purpose of the closure is to provide for public health and safety during fire suppression activities on the Peterson Hollow fire.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until further notice.
2. Attached map shows the area affected by this Order.
3. Violation of the above prohibition(s) is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization and/or imprisonment for not more than 6 months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b) (6), Title 18 USC 3581(b) (7)].

5. This Order supersedes any previous Order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this Order in the area covered by this Order.
